Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct sets out expectations for behaviour at Himley Hall Golf Club to ensure an enjoyable and respectful environment for all members, guests, and staff. Adherence to these guidelines helps maintain the integrity and reputation of our club.

1. General Expectations

- Treat all members, guests, and staff with respect and courtesy at all times.
- Demonstrate honesty, sportsmanship, and fairness both on and off the course.
- Uphold the rules, values, and traditions of the game of golf.
- Avoid any behaviour that could be perceived as harassment, discrimination, or intimidation.

2. On the Course

- Follow proper golf etiquette, including:
 - Maintaining pace of play to avoid delays.
 - Repairing divots, ball marks, and raking bunkers after use.
 - Keeping noise levels low to respect other players.
 - Respect the course.
 - Avoid littering or damaging the course.
 - Adhere to local course rules, including dress code.
 - Refrain from disruptive behaviour such as excessive shouting, inappropriate language, or throwing clubs.
 - Adhere to the Rules of Golf as governed by the R&A.

3. Clubhouse and Outdoor Space

- Dress appropriately in accordance

with the club's dress code.

- Use respectful and considerate language and behaviour at all times.
- Avoid excessive noise or disruptive behaviour that could disturb others.
- Respect shared spaces, leaving them clean and tidy for others.
- Treat club facilities and property with care.

4. Interactions with Staff

- Show courtesy and respect to all club staff members.
- Address concerns or issues with staff professionally and constructively.
- Follow staff instructions regarding course rules, policies and safety.

5. Alcohol and Substance Use

- Consume alcohol responsibly and within the limits established by the club.
- Refrain from using illegal substances or becoming intoxicated to the point of

impairing judgment or behaviour.

6. Safety and Security

- Prioritise the safety of yourself and others at all times.
- Avoid reckless behaviour that could cause injury or damage.
- Report any hazards, accidents, or misconduct to club management promptly.

7. Disciplinary Action

Members or guests who fail to comply with this Code of Conduct may be subject to:

- A verbal or written warning.
- Suspension or revocation of club privileges.
- Removal from the course, clubhouse or outdoor space.
- Permanent termination of membership in severe or repeated cases.
